
How to configure Cabinet handles

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You can add or modify your Cabinet handles at any time during the design process. To do this:

- 1. **Select** an existing **cabinet** (or create a new one)
- 2. Open the Cadimage Cabinets Settings dialogue
- 3. Choose **Handles** from the menu:




- 4. Click the Handle Type button (shown above)
- 5. Choose from a range of handle designs:

TIP: Depending on the handle chosen, you will see a different range of settings to modify its' appearance.


In this example, the Full Length handle has been chosen

6. Configure your handle as shown below:





7. Go to the 'Position on Drawers' twirl-down item to change the position of the handle on your door/drawer:



The positioning options for a *drawer* (shown above) are:

- 1. Position on Drawers which can be Top, Centre or None
- 2. Offset Up
- 3. **Separation** (if you want two handles)
- 4. Rotation Angle

The positioning options for a *door* (shown below) are:

- 1. Position on Doors which can be Top, Bottom or None
- 2. Offset Down
- 3. Offset from Door Edge
- 4. Rotation Angle
